 A) "The teacher asked the students" — Correct (past tense) B) "if they have completed" — Incorrect — Since the reporting verb "asked" is in past tense, the tense in reported speech should be past perfect, not present perfect. t should be: "if they had completed" C) "their homework" — Fine D) "before coming to class" — Fine
Final Answer:
B)if they have completed → if they had completed

Corrected Sentence:

The teacher asked the students if they had completed their homework before coming to class.
