### Sentence:

- A) The teacher asked the students
- B) if they have completed
- C) their homework
- D) before coming to class.
- E) No error.

### Options:

- A)
- B)
- C)
- D)
- E) No error

### Solution:

Let's check each part:

- A) "The teacher asked the students" — ✓ ☐ Correct (past tense)
- B) "if they have completed" — ✗ Incorrect  
→ Since the reporting verb "asked" is in **past tense**, the tense in reported speech should be **past perfect**, not present perfect.
  - t should be: "if they had completed"
- C) "their homework" — ✓ ☐ Fine
- D) "before coming to class" — ✓ ☐ Fine

### Final Answer:

B) if they have completed → if they had completed

### Corrected Sentence:

The teacher asked the students if they had completed their homework before coming to class.
