



* Word Substitution

Definition:

Word substitution refers to **replacing a group of words or a full phrase** with a **single word** that conveys the **same meaning**. This helps in making writing or speech more **concise** and **effective**.

✓ Examples:

Phrase	One Word Substitution
A person who writes poems	Poet
A life story written by oneself	Autobiography
One who can speak many languages	Polyglot
A person who hates mankind	Misanthrope
A speech made on the spot without preparation	Extempore
A place where books are kept	Library
