

What is Logical Sequencing?

Definition

Arranging words, phrases, and clauses in a sensible order.

Purpose

Ensures relationships between ideas are clear to readers.

Outcome

Builds a cohesive and persuasive argument.

Principles of Logical Sequencing

Chronological Order

Events unfold in time sequence.

Spatial Order

Describing location from a specific point.

Order of Importance

Building from least to most significant.

Cause and Effect

Connections between actions and results.

Strategies for Effective Sequencing

Use Transitions

Guide readers smoothly between ideas.

Clear Topic Sentences

Map out main ideas for each paragraph.

Create Outlines

Plan order before writing.

Parallel Structure

Maintain consistency in phrasing.




Transition Words and Phrases

Examples of Logical Sequencing

Before

She ate breakfast, brushed her teeth, and woke up.

After

She woke up, brushed her teeth, and ate breakfast.

Before

The dog barked loudly, scaring the mailman next door.

After

The dog next door barked loudly, scaring the mailman.
