PRESIDENT OF INDIA

Position:

- Head of the State
- First citizen of India
- Part of the **Parliament** (along with Rajya Sabha and Lok Sabha)
- **Nominal Executive** (functions on the advice of the Prime Minister and Council of Ministers)

Election:

- Elected indirectly by an electoral college:
 - o Elected members of both Houses of Parliament
 - o Elected members of State Legislative Assemblies
- Elected for a term of 5 years
- Can be re-elected

Qualifications:

- Citizen of India
- At least 35 years of age
- Qualified to be elected as a Lok Sabha member
- Should not hold any office of profit

Powers & Functions:

1. Legislative:

- Summons and dissolves Parliament
- o Gives assent to bills
- o Issues ordinances when Parliament is not in session

2. Executive:

 Appoints Prime Minister, Governors, Judges of Supreme Court and High Courts, Election Commissioners, etc.

3. Judicial:

o Can grant pardons, reprieves, respites to convicts

4. Emergency:

o Can declare National, State, and Financial Emergencies

5. Diplomatic:

- o Represents India in international forums
- o Signs treaties (with Parliament's approval)

VICE PRESIDENT OF INDIA

Position:

- Second-highest constitutional authority in India
- Ex-officio Chairperson of the Rajya Sabha

Election:

- Elected indirectly by an electoral college:
 - o Members of both Houses of Parliament (Lok Sabha + Rajya Sabha)
- Elected for a term of 5 years
- Can be re-elected

Qualifications:

- Citizen of India
- At least 35 years of age
- Qualified to be elected as a Rajya Sabha member
- Should not hold any office of profit

Functions:

- 1. Presides over Rajya Sabha
 - o Maintains order and discipline in the House
- 2. Acts as President in the event of:
 - Death, resignation, removal, or absence of the President (until a new President is elected)
