Transformation Process:



The transformation process is a key concept in operations management that refers to the conversion of inputs into outputs through a series of activities or processes.

It involves the transformation of

- Raw materials
- Components
- or information into finished goods or services that are delivered to customers.





Transformation Key Stages:

INPUT
TRANSFORMATION
LOADING

- Input: This stage involves acquiring the necessary inputs, such as raw materials, components, or information, for the transformation process.
- Transformation: This stage involves the actual transformation of the inputs into outputs. This may involve manufacturing processes, assembly, packaging, or service delivery.





CONTD...





- Output: This stage involves the delivery of the finished goods or services to customers.
- Feedback: This stage involves monitoring and evaluating the output to identify opportunities for improvement in the transformation process.



Transformation Process classified into two types:



- Manufacturing transformation process: This process is primarily concerned with the production of tangible goods. The inputs in this process are raw materials and components, and the output is a finished product.
- Service transformation process: This process is primarily concerned with the delivery of intangible services. The inputs in this process are customer requirements, and the output is a service that meets the customer's needs.
