Focused on minimizing the environmental impact of logistics activities. This includes optimizing transportation routes, reducing emissions, and implementing sustainable practices in warehousing and packaging.





Global Logistics

Deals with the management of logistics across international borders. It involves handling international shipping, customs regulations, and global supply chain coordination.







Just-in-Time (JIT) Logistics

A strategy aimed at reducing inventory levels and minimizing storage costs by receiving goods only as they are needed in the production process.







E-commerce Logistics

Tailored to the specific needs of online retail, including managing inventory, order processing, and last-mile delivery to customers.





Freight Logistics

Focuses on the transportation of goods, including managing the movement of cargo by road, rail, air, or sea.
