Riddle 2 I am a word that shows action happening right now, but tomorrow I'll change. What am I?

Answer: Present tense (am).

Riddle 3 I will be going to the store later, but right now, I am here with you. What tense is my future action in?

Answer: Future tense (will be going).

Riddle 4 I was running in the park when I heard a noise, but now I am quiet. What tense did I use to describe my action?

Answer: Past continuous tense (was running).

Riddle 5 I am a word that can show you something done before, but when you add "will," I change to show what's to come. What tense am I?

Answer: Perfect tense (have/had, when paired with "will" for future perfect).

Riddle 6 I talk about things that will happen at some point in the future, but right now I'm stuck in the present. What tense am I?

Answer: Future tense (will).

Riddle 7 I am a tense that describes actions that were happening continuously in the past. What am I?

Answer: Past continuous tense (was/were + verb-ing).

Riddle 8 I'm a tense that shows you an action completed before another past action. What tense am I?

Answer: Past perfect tense (had + past participle).

Riddle 9 I am used for habits and routines that happen regularly, but I can also describe something true now. What tense am I?

Answer: Present simple tense (do/does).

Riddle 10 I am a form that helps you talk about experiences you've had, but I also reveal something that's still true. What tense am I?

Answer: Present perfect tense (have/has + past participle).
