# **IF CONDITIONALS**

Clause

A grammatical unit which has got subject and predicate and it forms the part of a sentence is called a clause.

A conditional sentence has two parts-If clause and Main clause.

They are used to express an action, then along with that it has a condition.

### 1)Open Condition (Likely to happen)

Format: If clause + Simple present + Main clause (sub + will/shall / can /may )+ V1

Eg:1) If I go to Delhi, I will visit Tajmahal.

2) If you study well, you will pass the exam.

## 2) Improbable Condition (Unlikely to happen)

 $Format\ -\ If\ clause\ +\ Simple\ past+\ Main\ clause\ (sub\ +\ would/should/could/\ might\ )+\ V1$ 

Eg.1) If you invited me, I would come to the function.

2) If you asked me, I would give it to you.

3)Impossible Condition (Never and going to happen )

Format :If clause+ Past perfect(had+V3)+Main clause (sub + would, should, could, might+ have )+ V3

Eg:-. 1)If you had studied well, youwould have passed the exam.

2) If you had informed me, I would have kept him at a distance.

#### 4) Zero Condition

This is a Universal Truth. Universal truth is always conveyed in simple present tense. This is called zero condition.

Eg: 1) If you heat water at  $100^{\circ}$  c , it boils.

2) If it rains, the ground gets wet.
