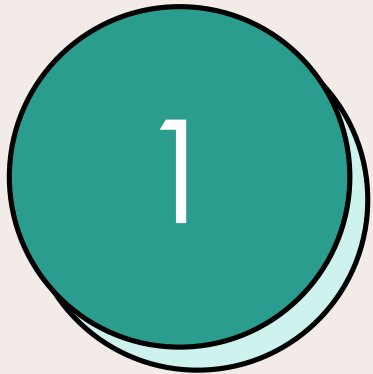

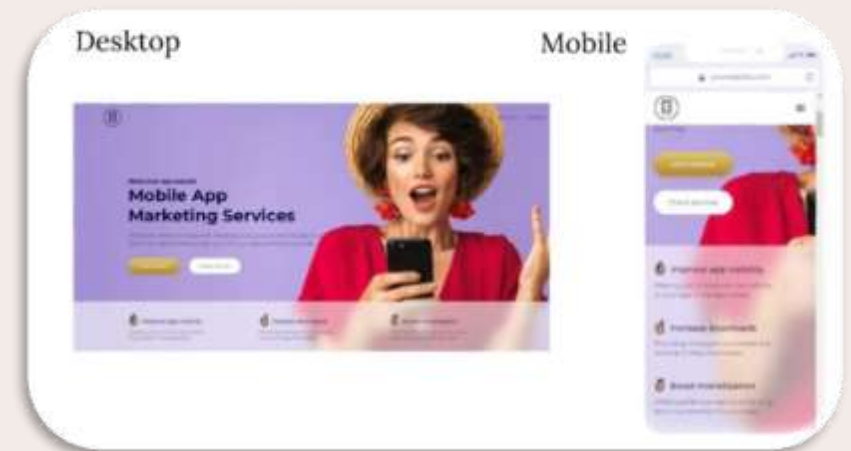

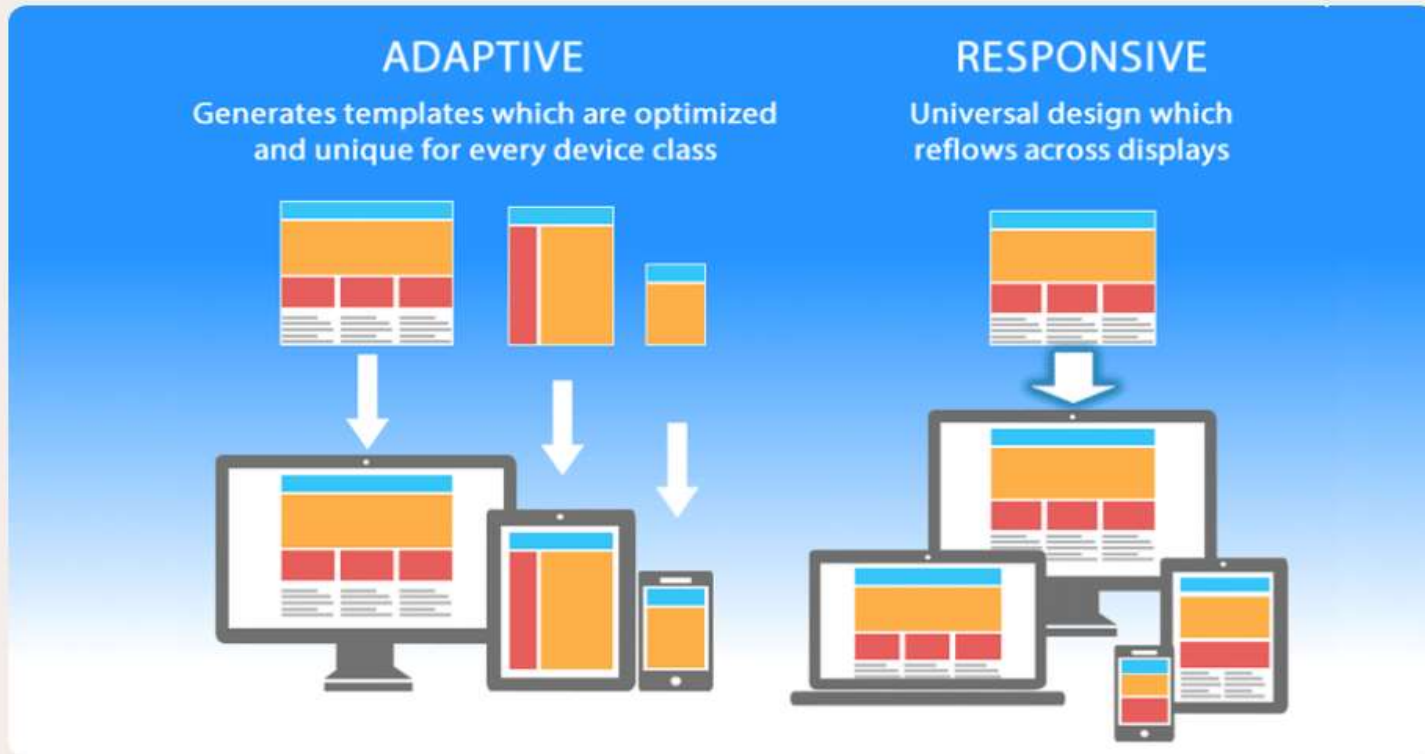
What is Responsive Web

- ✓ Responsive web design uses code that automatically adjusts the design to different screens based on their sizes and resolutions.
- ✓ It's what allows users to have a smooth experience of a web page regardless of whether they're viewing it on a wide desktop monitor or small mobile screen.





Responsive Web Design vs Adaptive Web Design



- ✓ Responsive design adapts the rendering of a single page version.
- ✓ Adaptive design delivers multiple completely different versions of the same page.



RWD vs AWD

Responsive web design

Dynamically changes a site's page layout based on a device's display type, width, height, etc.

Uses CSS media queries to change styles

A designer creates one flexible layout that changes according to device.

Works best for larger sites that are being designed for the first time

Adaptive web design

Detects the screen size and loads the appropriate layout for it

Uses static layouts based on breakpoints that don't respond once they're loaded

Requires creating a different layout for every device, for example, separate web and mobile versions

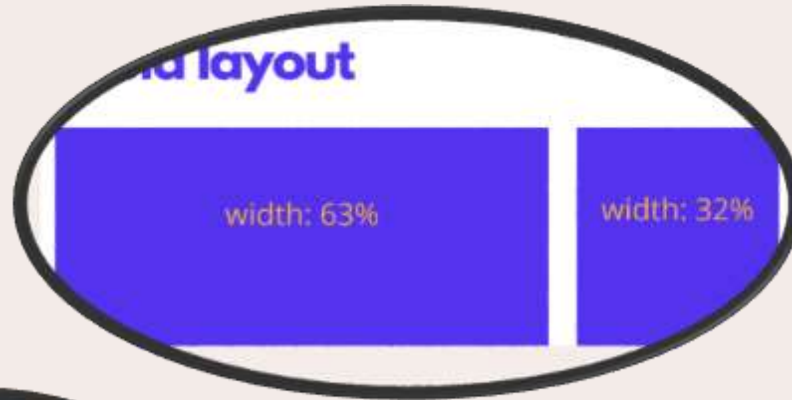
Works best for smaller sites that need to be redesigned or refreshed

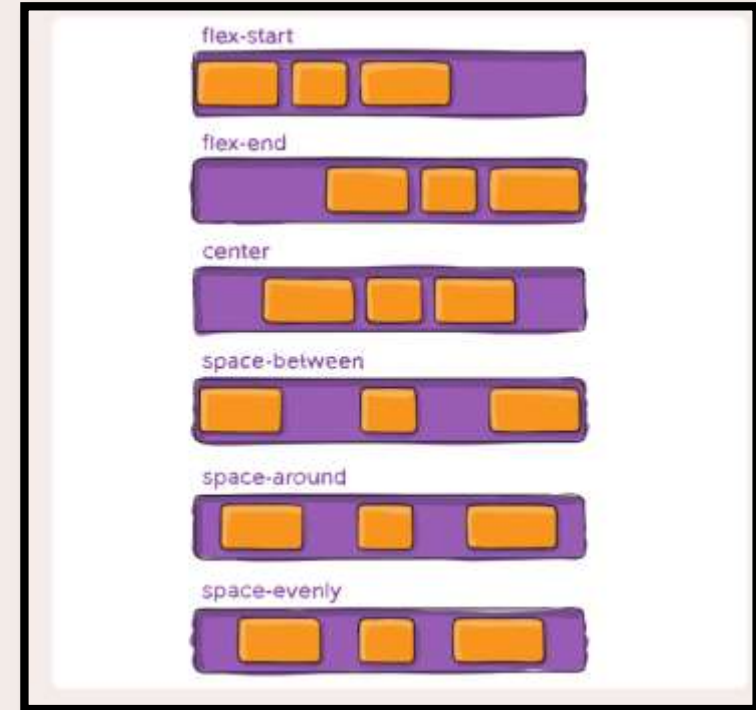

Speed

- ✓ When you're attempting to create a responsive design for your website, the loading speed should be a top priority.
- ✓ Pages that load in 2 seconds have an average 9% bounce rate, while pages that take 5 seconds lead to a 38% bounce rate.



Common Responsive Breakpoints

The “responsive breakpoints” or screen size breakpoints. A breakpoint is the width of the screen where you use a media query to implement new CSS styles.

Common screen sizes

- Mobile: 360 x 640
- Mobile: 375 x 667
- Mobile: 360 x 720
- iPhone X: 375 x 812
- Pixel 2: 411 x 731
- Tablet: 768 x 1024
- Laptop: 1366 x 768
- High-res laptop or desktop: 1920 x 1080

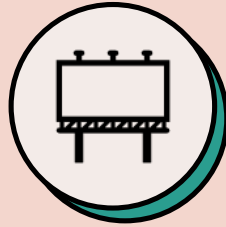

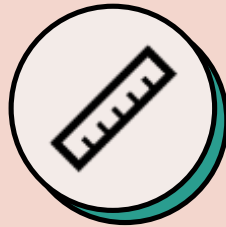

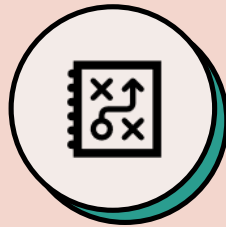
