- · He tried to murder him by throwing him down from 'Acropolis', Athens
- In Greek, "Acro" means Highest Point & "Polis" means City
- · Acropolis is an ancient citadel located on a flattish rock, above the city of Athens, Greece





- Daedulus & his son Icarus were imprisoned in the Mediterranean sea
- Daedulus is said to have made wings fastened with Wax
- With the wings they escaped flying through air
- · Against his Father's warnings, Icarus flew close to the sun
