IF CONDITIONALS



- **A** conditional sentence has two parts such as If clause and Main Clause.
- **Usually the condition is expressed** in if clause.

If Clause	Main Clause
if it rains	I'll stay at Home





TYPES OF CONDITIONALS





- There are four conditional sentences in English
- Type1:Open or Probable Condition
- Type2:Improble or imaginary Condition
- *Type3:Impossible or Unfulfilled
- **Type4: Zero Condition**



OPEN or PROBABLE CONDITION



If Clause

if + present simple

Main Clause

modal verb with future meaning (shall/should/will/would/can/could/may/might)

Examples:



If Clause+Pre

If I go to Delhi, I will Visit Tajmahal Main Clause





IMPROBABLE or IMAGINARY CONDITION



If Clause

if + Past Simple

Main Clause

modal verb with future-in-the-past meaning (should/would/might/could)

Examples

If I were a bird,
If Clause+Past

I would fly in the sky
Main Clause

UNFULFILLED or IMPOSSIBLE CONDITION



If Clause

if + Past perfect (had)

Main Clause

modal verb with future-in-the-past meaning (should/would/might/could) + have + -ed form

Examples

If I had written my exams well well, I would have passed my exams

If Clause+Past.perfect

Main Clause







ZERO CONDITION



If Clause

if + *Present simple*

Main Clause

Present simple

Examples



If I over sleep, I miss the bus If Clause+pre Main Clause
