'IF' CONDITIONALS

- Conditional sentence has two parts – '**If**' clause and **Main Clause**
- Usually the **Condition** is Expressed in '**If**' clause





FOUR BASIC CONDITIONALS



1. Zero conditional
2. First conditional (Open Or Probable Condition)
3. Second conditional (Improbable Or Imaginary Condition)
4. Third conditional (Unfulfilled Or Impossible Condition)



ZERO CONDITIONAL

If Clause	Main Clause
<i>If + Present simple</i>	<i>+ Present simple</i>

EXAMPLE:

- If you heat ice, it melts.
- If you don't water the garden, the plants die.



FIRST CONDITIONAL

If Clause	Main Clause
<i>If + present simple</i>	+ Simple future (<i>shall/should/will/would/can/could/may/might</i>)

EXAMPLES:

- If it rains, we will get wet.
- If Jim has the money, he will buy a book.



SECOND CONDITIONAL

If Clause	Main Clause
<i>if + Past Simple</i>	<i>+ Would + infinitive</i>

EXAMPLES:

- **If i had money, i would lend it to you.**



THIRD CONDITIONAL

If Clause	Main Clause
<i>if + Past perfect</i>	<i>+ Would + present perfect</i>

EXAMPLE:

- **If it had rained** last night, it **wouldn't have been** so hot today



OTHER CONDITIONAL EXPRESSIONS



Unless	Even Though/Even If	And/Or Else
--------	---------------------	-------------

EXAMPLES:

1. If they _____carefully, they might hear the woodpecker
2. If I had lain down on the sofa, I _____ asleep.
3. Susan could have worked as a model if she _____ taller
