Forms of Plagiarism:

Direct Plagiarism: Copying text or data word-for-word without citation.

Self-Plagiarism: Reusing your own previously published work without disclosure.

Mosaic Plagiarism: Paraphrasing someone else's work by changing words or structure without proper citation.

Accidental Plagiarism: Unintentionally failing to cite sources or misunderstandings about what constitutes plagiarism.



Preventing Plagiarism:

Proper Citation Practices: Always give credit to the original authors when using their ideas, data, or text. Familiarize yourself with the appropriate citation style for your field (e.g., APA, IEEE, Chicago).

Original Work: Strive to produce original work and contribute new ideas to your field. If you rely on existing research, ensure that you synthesize the information rather than merely copying it.

Use of Plagiarism Detection Tools: Many institutions use plagiarism detection software to check the originality of work. These tools can help identify unintentional plagiarism and ensure that proper citations are used.
