Professional Rights

PROFESSIONAL RIGHTS

- The right to form and *express one's professional judgment freely.*
- The right to *refuse to carry out illegal and unethical activity.*
- The right to *talk publicly* about one's work *within bounds* set by confidentiality obligation.
- The right to *engage* in the activities of *professional societies.*
- The right to *protect* the clients and the public *from the dangers* that might arise from one's work.
- The right to professional *recognition* of one's services.



Professional Rights



Definition:

Professional rights refer to the entitlements and protections afforded to individuals in their professional roles. These can include the right to a fair working environment, the right to be treated with respect, and the right to work without discrimination or harassment.

Scope:

Professional rights often align with broader legal and ethical standards governing workplace behavior and practices.



Right to Fair Treatment:

Ensuring that individuals are treated equitably and without bias.

Right to Privacy:

Protecting personal and professional information from unauthorized disclosure.

Right to Due Process:

Providing fair procedures for addressing grievances or disciplinary actions.
