#### PROFESSIONAL RIGHTS

- The right to form and express one's professional judgment freely.
- The right to refuse to carry out illegal and unethical activity.
- The right to talk publicly about one's work within bounds set by confidentiality obligation.
- The right to engage in the activities of professional societies.
- The right to protect the clients and the public from the dangers that might arise from one's work.
- The right to professional recognition of one's services.



# **Professional Rights**



#### Definition:

Professional rights refer to the entitlements and protections afforded to individuals in their professional roles. These can include the right to a fair working environment, the right to be treated with respect, and the right to work without discrimination or harassment.

### Scope:

Professional rights often align with broader legal and ethical standards governing workplace behavior and practices.



## **Professional Rights**



Right to Fair Treatment:

Ensuring that individuals are treated equitably and without bias.

Right to Privacy:

Protecting personal and professional information from unauthorized disclosure.

Right to Due Process:

Providing fair procedures for addressing grievances or disciplinary actions.
