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## Employee rights are any rights , moral or legal, that involve the status of being an employee. They include some professional rights that apply to the employer-employee relationship. Employee rights include fundamental human rights relevant to the employment situation. • e.g. the right not to be discriminated against one's race, sex, age or national origin. 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**Definition:** Employee rights are the legal and ethical entitlements of workers in the workplace. These rights are designed to protect employees from unfair treatment and ensure a safe, equitable, and respectful working environment.

**Scope:** Employee rights typically cover areas such as:

Wage and Hour Rights: Fair compensation, overtime pay, and appropriate working hours.

Health and Safety: Safe working conditions and protection from workplace hazards.





**Anti-Discrimination:** Protection against discrimination based on race, gender, age, disability, and other characteristics.

**Right to Unionize:** The right to join or form trade unions and engage in collective bargaining.

**Right to Privacy:** Safeguards against unwarranted surveillance or invasion of personal privacy.







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
